



## SMART SERVING THE NORTH BAY

Sonoma-Marín Area Rail Transit (SMART) is the Bay Area's newest passenger rail service providing a safe, reliable and congestion-free transportation option for Marin and Sonoma counties. The initial 43-mile system includes stations in the Sonoma County Airport area, Santa Rosa, Rohnert Park, Cotati, Petaluma, Novato and San Rafael. SMART's system also includes a bicycle and pedestrian pathway along the rail corridor. SMART's rail service includes a Larkspur extension, which is slated to open by the end of 2019. Future extensions are planned for Windsor, Healdsburg and Cloverdale, completing the vision for a full 70-mile system.



### WELCOME ABOARD

SMART uses the Clipper card system, the same payment system used by other Bay Area transit providers, for a seamless trip. Clipper cards are available at all SMART stations, or online at [ClipperCard.com](http://ClipperCard.com). SMART fares are based on the distance traveled, with 50 percent discounts available for seniors, youth, and for passengers with disabilities. Discount Clipper cards can be obtained at transit customer service centers, with proper verification.

For those who wish to purchase fares for multiple riders, or who may not have a Clipper card, we recommend using SMART's mobile ticketing app. To install the app, search for "SMART eTickets" where you download your mobile apps.

Substantial commuter discounts are available through SMART's annual Eco-Pass or SMART's 31-Day Pass program. SMART's passenger train service includes 34 trips each weekday, and 10 trips each Saturday and Sunday. The weekend runs are designed to connect with the Larkspur Ferry.

SMART has onboard spaces for bicycles and bicycle parking at all of its stations. SMART also allows service animals on board, and is fully compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Safety is our top priority. Please be sure to stand clear of the platform edge at all times, and stay behind the yellow strip prior to boarding. Always allow people to exit the train before you board. Sit back, relax, and enjoy the ride.
