

Description of Service

Riding SMART and finding connecting transit service to San Francisco is easy, as long as you know which routes to take! Once SMART drops you off at the San Rafael Station, cross the street to the San Rafael Transit Center (be safe—cross only at the crosswalks!). From the Transit Center, Golden Gate Transit (GGT) and Marin Transit provide several options to the Golden Gate Larkspur Ferry Terminal, where you can continue your journey by ferry. Golden Gate Transit also provides direct bus service from the Transit Center into San Francisco on Routes 27, 70, and 101.

The most convenient connections to/from SMART are shown here, but check online (goldengate.org and marintransit.org) or in the *Golden Gate Transit Guide* and *Marin Transit Rider's Guide* for a complete list of trips.

FREE Shuttle for Larkspur Ferry Customers

Route 31 is FREE for Larkspur Ferry customers. Just tag your Clipper card when you board and get off the shuttle, and again when boarding the ferry. The fare for passengers who do not ride the Ferry is \$1.80 (adult Clipper), \$2.00 (adult cash), and \$1.00 (youth, senior, disabled).

Transfer Credits Between SMART and GGT/Marin Transit

GGT and Marin Transit accept SMART transfers for a \$1.50 fare credit for adults (\$0.75 for youth/senior/disabled). SMART accepts GGT and Marin Transit transfers for a \$1.50 fare credit for adults (\$1.25 for youths, \$0.75 for senior/disabled). Fare credits are only issued when using cash value (not passes) on Clipper. *No fare credits are issued when using SMART app tickets (eTickets).*

Accessible Services

All GGT buses are lift-equipped with a “kneeling feature” for easier boarding. Not all GGT bus stops are accessible to wheelchairs. All Golden Gate Ferries are accessible to passengers using wheelchairs and all have accessible restrooms.

Bikes on Golden Gate Transit & Ferry

All GGT buses are equipped with bike racks. Buses that do not have exterior front racks are equipped with underbelly bike racks. Some San Francisco bus stops prevent the use of the underbelly bike rack due to safety or operational reasons (see list at goldengatetransit.org/bikes). Bikes are welcome aboard all Golden Gate Ferries on a first-come, first-served basis. Bike parking is located at the San Rafael Transit Center and inside the secure waiting area at the Larkspur Ferry Terminal.

Descripción del servicio

Es fácil viajar con SMART y encontrar el servicio de conexión a San Francisco, ¡siempre y cuando usted sepa qué rutas tomar! Una vez que SMART le deja en la estación de San Rafael, cruce la calle hasta el San Rafael Transit Center (cruce con seguridad – ¡sólo en los cruces peatonales!). Desde el Transit Center, Golden Gate Transit (GGT) y Marin Transit ofrecen varias opciones hacia la terminal de ferry de Larkspur de Golden Gate, donde puede continuar su viaje en ferry. Golden Gate Transit también ofrece servicio de autobús directo desde el Transit Center hacia San Francisco en las Rutas 27, 70 y 101.

Las conexiones más convenientes hacia/desde SMART se muestran aquí, pero consulte los sitios web (goldengate.org y marintransit.org) o la *Golden Gate Transit Guide* y la *Marin Transit Rider's Guide* para ver una lista completa de viajes.

Servicio de enlace GRATIS para los clientes de Larkspur Ferry

La Ruta 31 es GRATIS para los clientes de Larkspur Ferry. Simplemente pase su tarjeta Clipper cuando suba y baje del servicio, y de nuevo cuando suba al ferry. La tarifa para los pasajeros que no viajan en el ferry es de \$1.80 (Clipper para adulto), \$2.00 (adulto en efectivo), y \$1.00 (jóvenes, mayores, discapacitados).

Créditos de transbordo entre SMART y GGT/Marin Transit

GGT y Marin Transit aceptan transbordos de SMART por un crédito de \$1.50 para adultos (\$0.75 para jóvenes/mayores/discapacitados). SMART acepta transbordos de GGT y Marin Transit por un crédito de \$1.50 para adultos (\$1.25 para jóvenes, \$0.75 para mayores/discapacitados). Los créditos de tarifa sólo se emiten cuando se usa Clipper. No se otorgan créditos de tarifa cuando se utilizan los eTickets de SMART.

Bicicletas en Golden Gate Transit y Ferry

Todos los autobuses de GGT están equipados con rejilla portabicicletas. Los autobuses que no tengan rejilla exterior delantera están equipados con una rejilla por debajo del autobús. Algunas paradas de autobús en San Francisco impiden el uso de la rejilla inferior debido a razones de seguridad u operacionales (ver la lista en goldengatetransit.org/bikes). Las bicis son bienvenidas a bordo de todos los barcos de transbordo de Golden Gate Ferry según vayan llegando hasta agotar el espacio. Hay estacionamiento para bicis disponible en el San Rafael Transit Center y dentro de la zona de espera segura en la terminal de Larkspur Ferry.

Servicios accesibles

Todos los autobuses de GGT están equipados con ascensor y pueden bajar la parte delantera para facilitar el abordaje. No todas las paradas de autobús de GGT son accesibles para sillas de ruedas. Todos los barcos de transbordo de Golden Gate Ferry son accesibles para los pasajeros que usan silla de ruedas y todos cuentan con baños accesibles.
