SMART to cancel Tuesday, October 29 train service due to Public Safety Power Shutdown impacts on local city traffic signal systems

Sonoma-Marín Area Rail Transit (SMART) has canceled train service for tomorrow, Tuesday, October 29, due to the Public Safety Power Shutdown impacts on local city traffic signal systems that cross SMART railroad tracks.

When PG&E turns the power back on, local jurisdictions have to reactivate all local traffic control systems and synchronize them with SMART railroad crossing warning devices. To protect the public safety by providing time for local jurisdictions to reactivate local traffic control systems, and to clear any newly downed trees from tracks due recent high winds, train service will be canceled on Tuesday, October 29.
