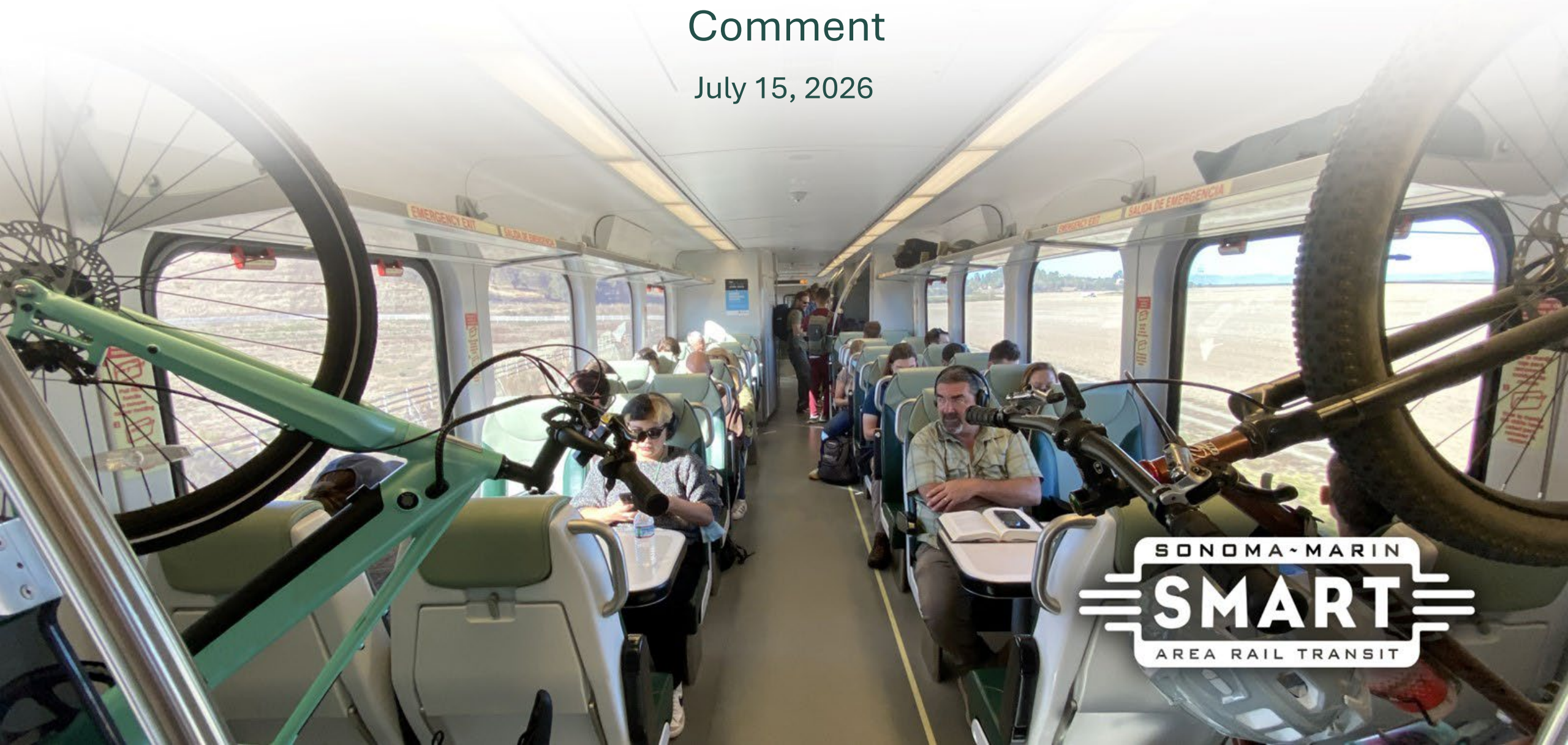

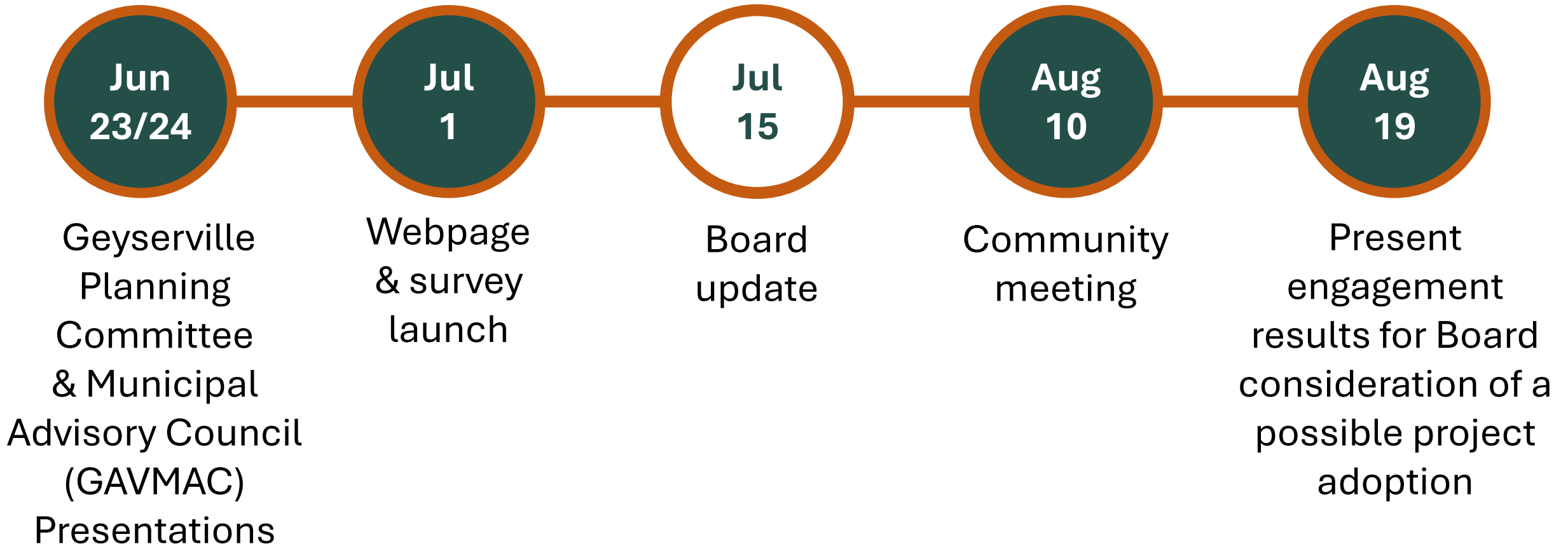

Inform-Why a Geyserville station?

- A Geyserville station would:
 - Allow train access for residents, workers, and visitors to Geyserville.
 - Maximize the utility of the rail system without harming railroad operations
 - Make more trips on the pathway between Cloverdale, Geyserville, and Healdsburg possible
 - Segment the delivery of the extension between Healdsburg and Cloverdale and create more opportunities to secure grant funding to complete the system



Inform-proposed station location

- Proposed station at Hwy 128 and Rimmel Rd
- Benefits:
 - Centrally located to housing, jobs, and business
 - Within SMART Right of Way
 - Within Geyserville urban service area
 - Under .25 miles to connecting transit service
 - Includes room for auto parking area



Listen and gather feedback- discussion questions and survey

Discussion Questions:

- Do you support Geyserville Station being added to the SMART system?
- Do you support the proposed location?
- Would another location along SMART right-of-way do a better job of connecting with other transit and connecting to high concentrations of destinations, people and jobs within Geyserville?

Survey:

- 10 questions focusing the addition of a station, the station location, potential use of the station and pathway, and work and housing locations
- Open from July 1-August 16 (47 days)
- In English and Spanish

Next steps

- Staff will summarize the input received through the engagement process and present it to the Board in August for the Board's consideration to approve and adopt the project into SMART's program
