Budget Amendment #10 – Amended Budget

Mid-Year Budget review process

Allows managers the opportunity to re-examine their fiscal year budget to

adjust to current spending rates

 Provides the opportunity to consider what projects can be started/completed before the end of the fiscal year

- Builds flexibility into the budgeting process, the ability to consider unforeseen circumstances and build these into the current year's spending plan
- Overall, this Amended Budget is reducing the FY2025 Budgeted Expenses and increasing the Budgeted Revenues, resulting in an increase to the fund balance of \$4,773,928

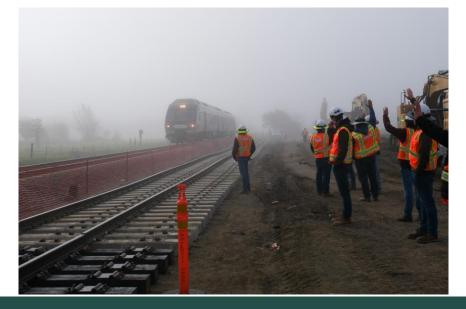
