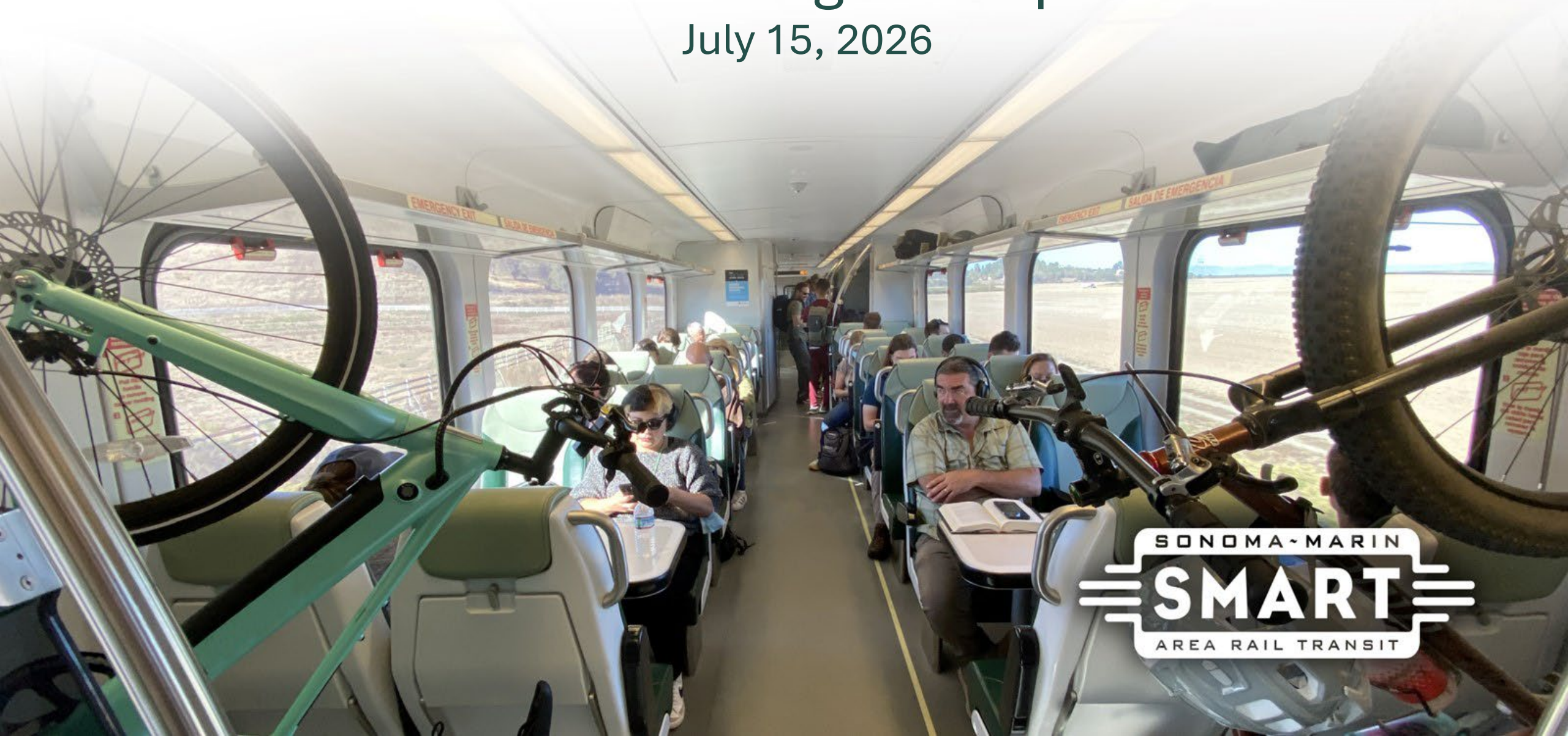

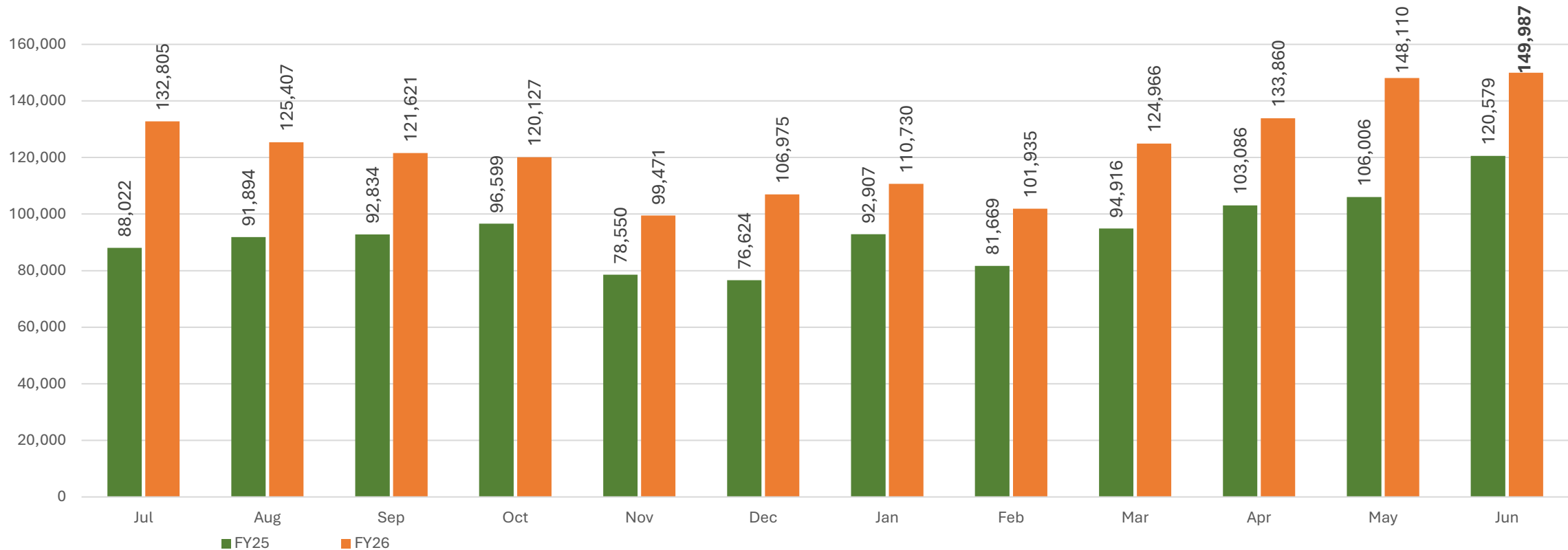

June ridership = 149,987

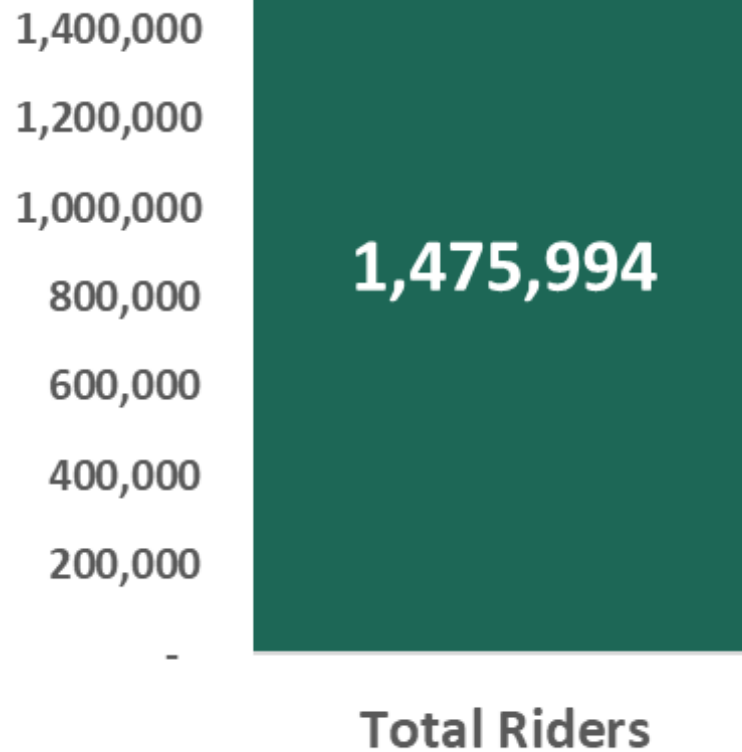
- 24% higher than June 2025
- New monthly record (3rd straight month)



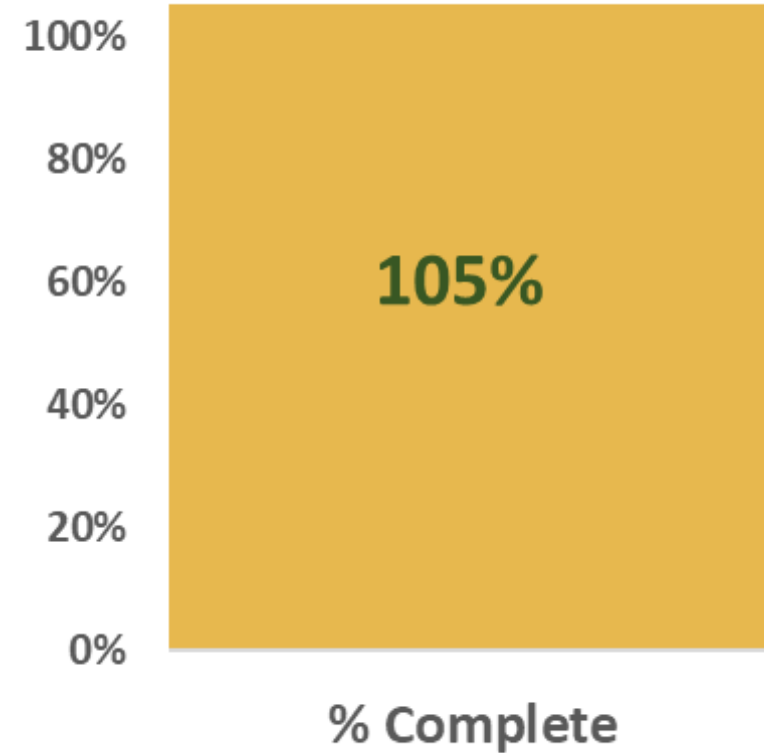
SMART to 1.4 Million Riders in FY26

Goal: 1.4M Riders in FY26

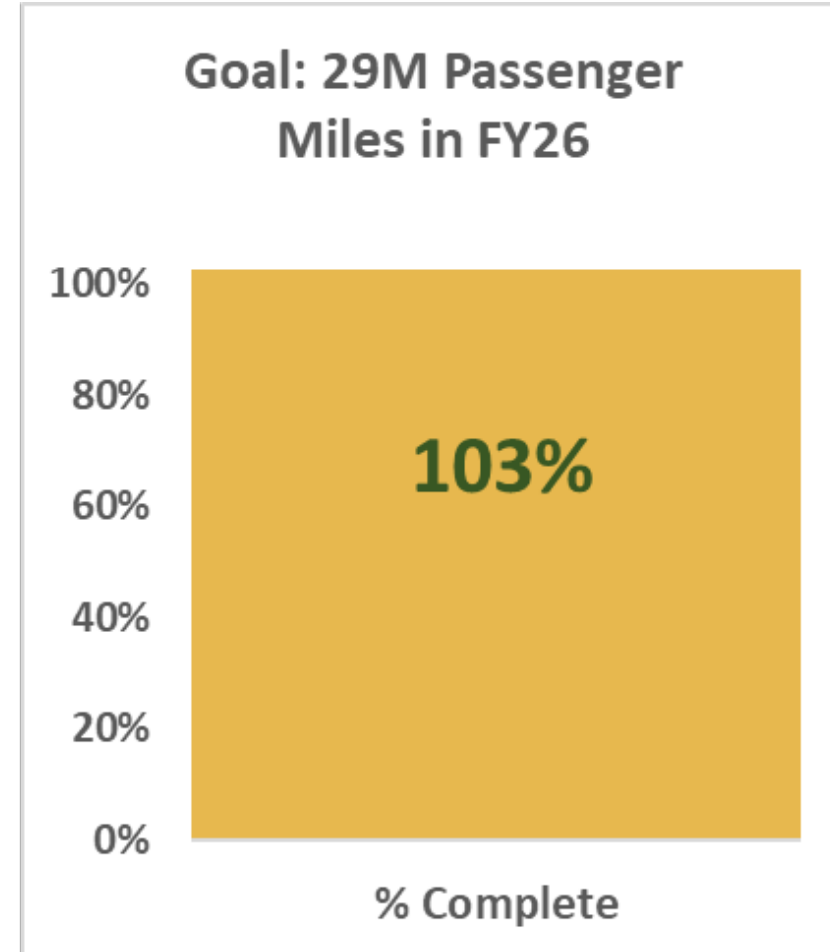
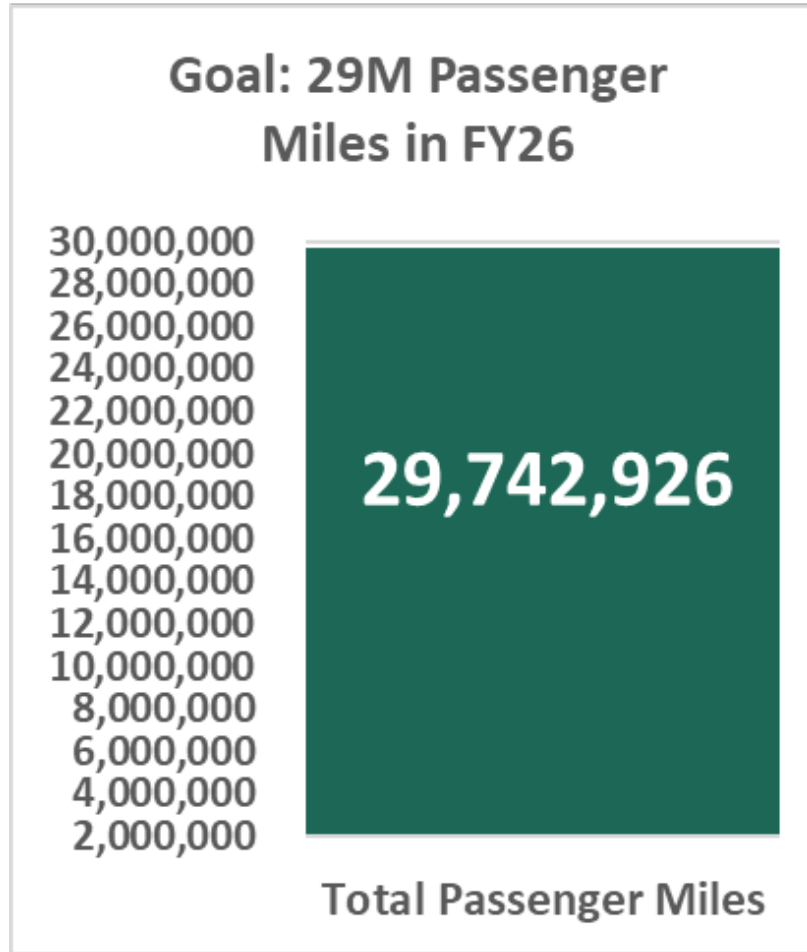


Goal: 1.4M Riders in FY26



SMART to 29M Passenger Miles in FY26

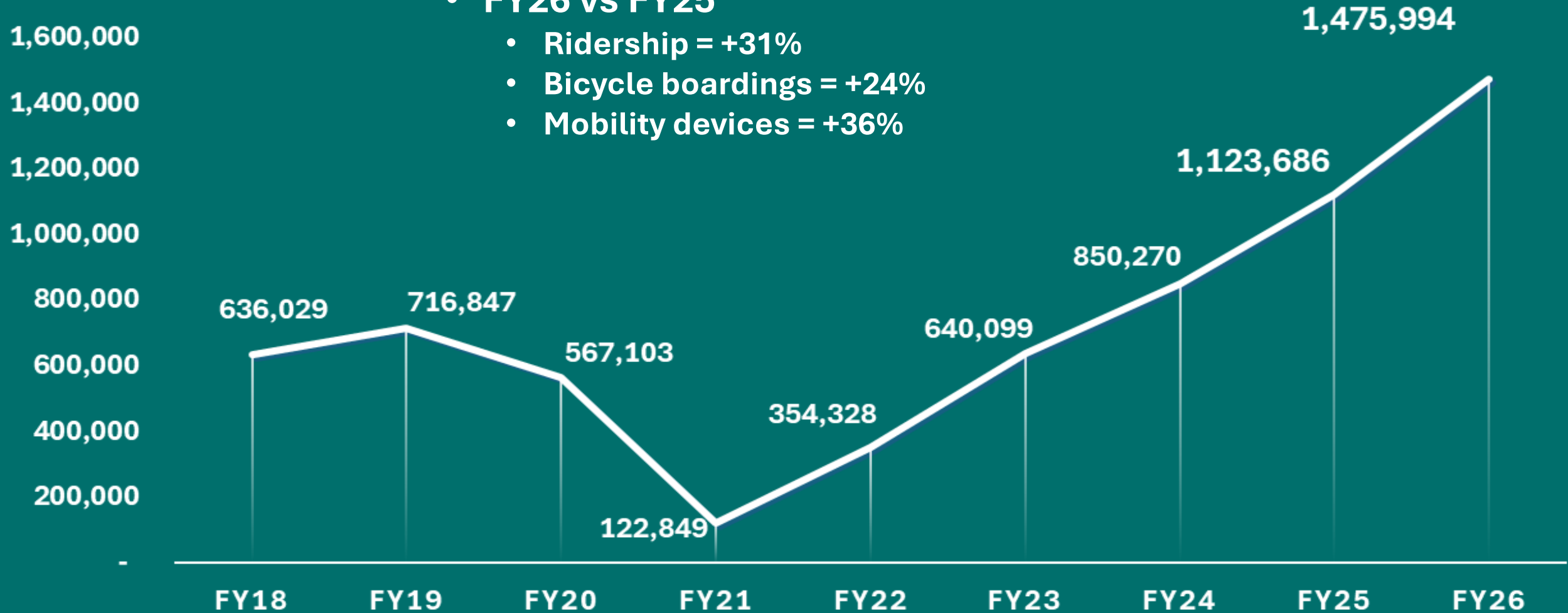

ANNUAL RIDERSHIP

- **FY26 vs FY25**
 - Ridership = +31%
 - Bicycle boardings = +24%
 - Mobility devices = +36%



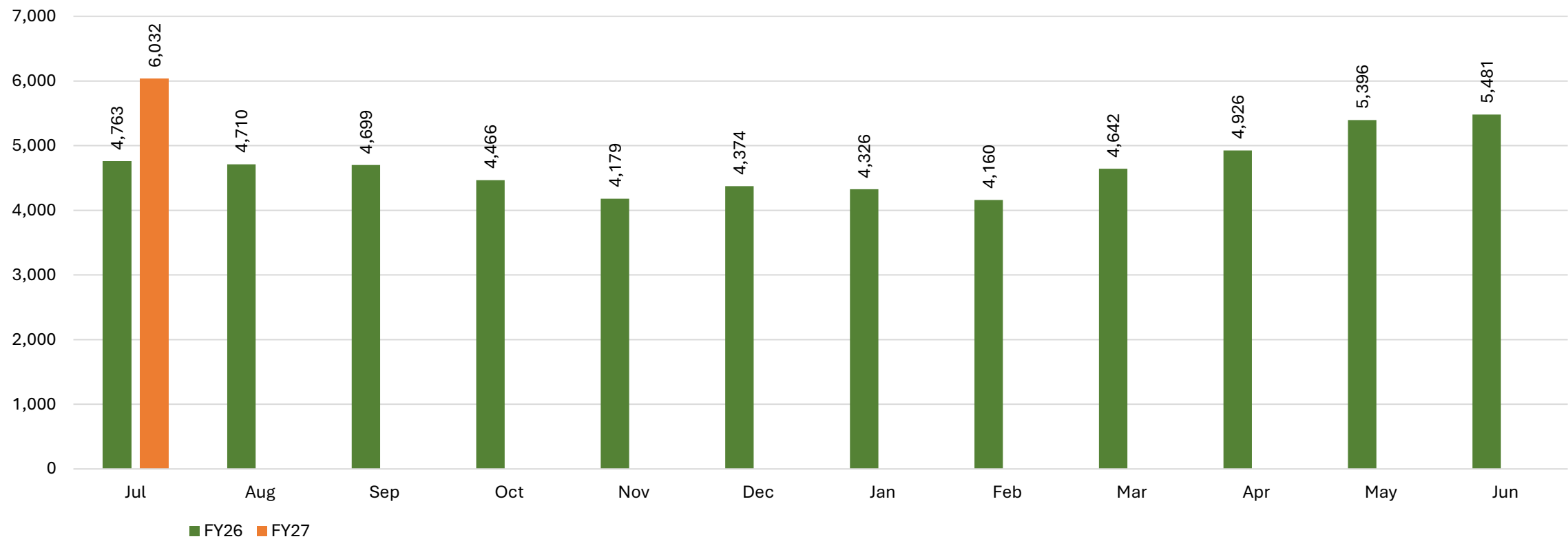
Average Weekday Ridership

June Average Weekday ridership: 5,481

- 21% over June 2025

July Average Weekday ridership to date: 6,032

- 27% over July 2025



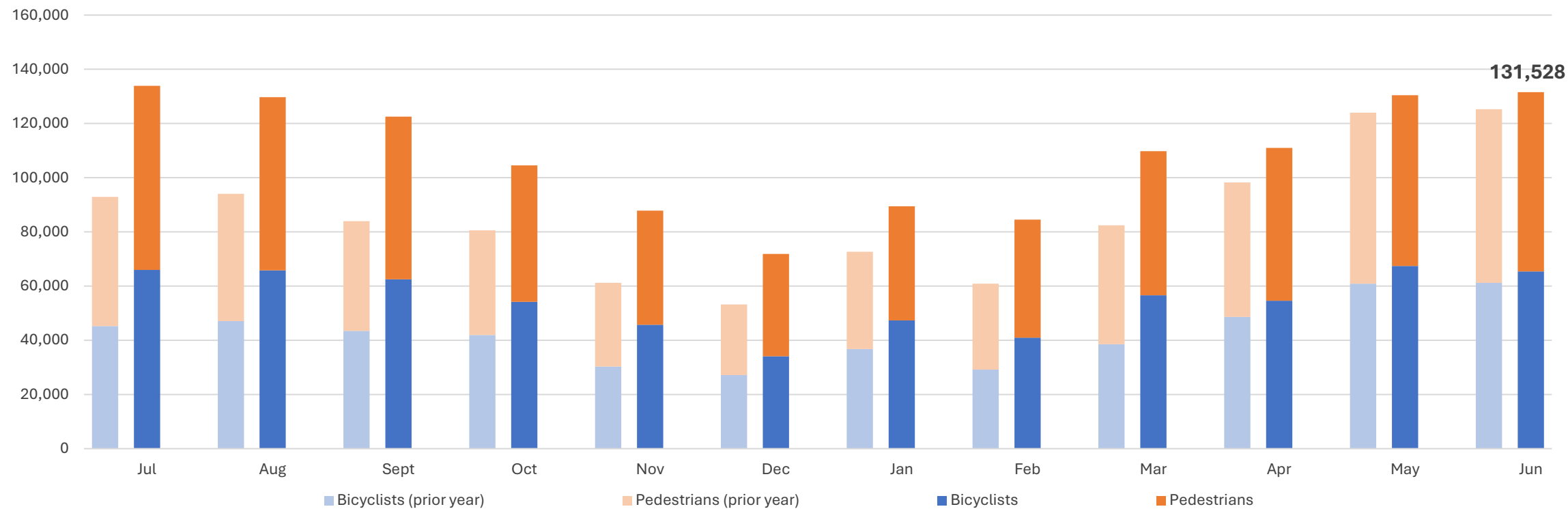
2026 Marin County Fair and Kaboom Ridership

- In partnership with Marin County Fair and Windsor Kaboom, SMART ran special service
- Provided **2,099 trips** to/from Windsor on July 3rd
 - Nearly 3 times the typical weekday boardings and alightings at Windsor
- Provided **11,747 trips** to/from Marin Civic Center Station over 5 days
 - Nearly 5 times the typical weekday boardings and alightings at Civic Center



SMART Pathway Counts

- June Pathway Trips = 131,528
 - 5% over June 2025



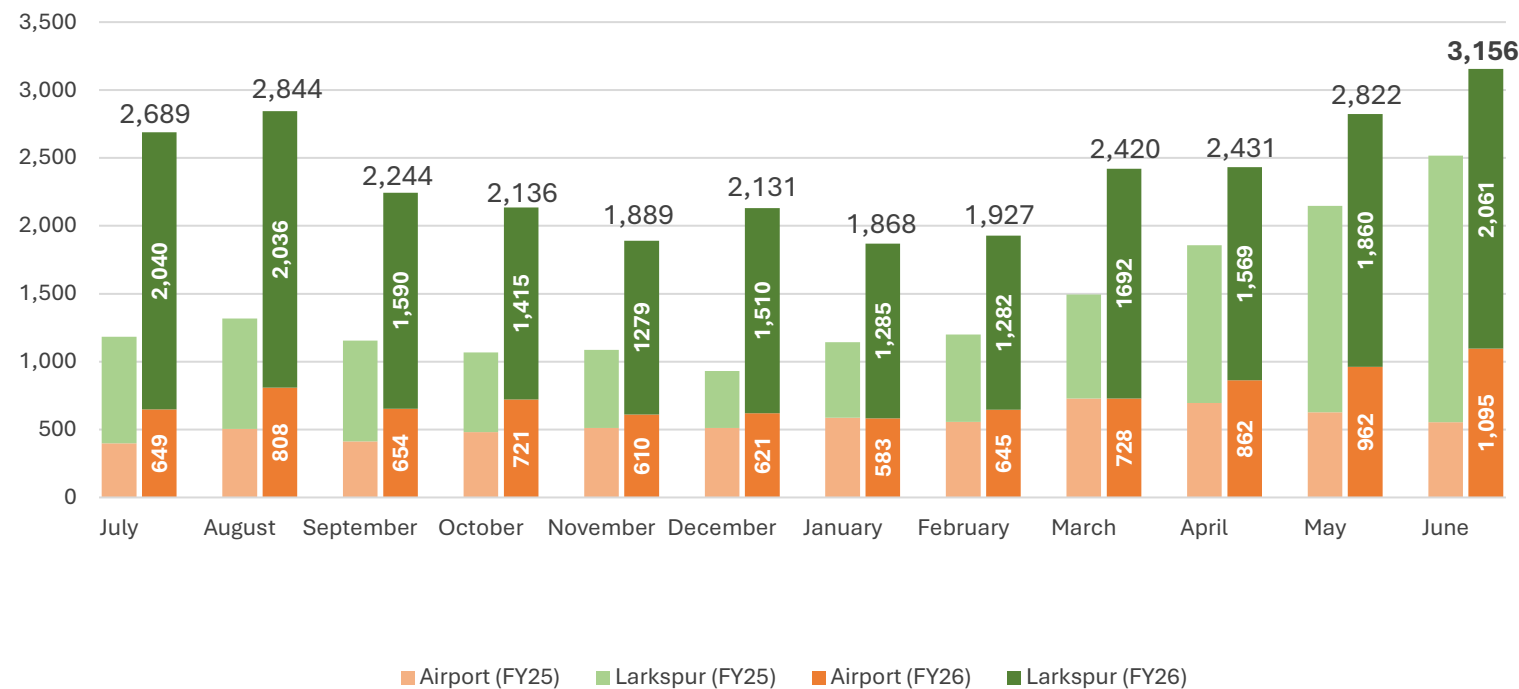
SMART Connect Ridership
