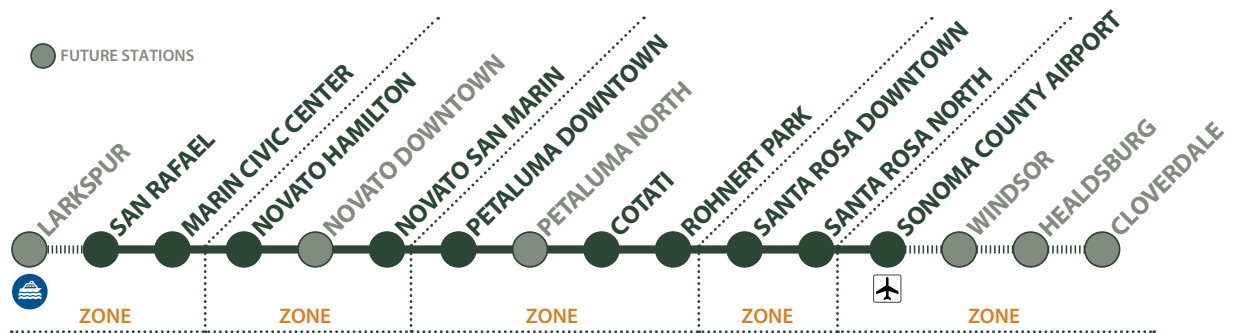




SMART FARE FACT SHEET



CLIPPER® CARDS

SMART uses Clipper cards, the same payment system used by other Bay Area transit providers, for a seamless trip. You can buy an adult Clipper card and add value or a 31-day pass to any Clipper card at any fare machine at SMART stations, online at www.Clippcard.com, or at participating transit agency ticket offices and retailers.

Discount Clipper cards and discount 31-day passes are available for youth (5-18), seniors (65 and over) and passengers with disabilities. Visit www.Clippcard.com/discounts for information on how to apply for a discounted card.

*Once the Daily Maximum is reached, all additional rides are free.

31-DAY PASS

SMART offers a 31-day pass for unlimited rides for 31-consecutive days from the date of first use. SMART's 31-Day Pass is an excellent option for commuters and is easy to use and to reload.

Seniors, youth, and passengers with disabilities (50%)	\$100.00

TRANSFER CREDITS

SMART passengers receive a \$1.50 discount (\$0.75 for youth, seniors and passengers with disabilities) when transferring to Golden Gate Transit, Marin Transit, Petaluma Transit, Santa Rosa CityBus or Sonoma County Transit. The same discount applies when you transfer from one of these public transit providers to SMART and pay with cash value.



USING CLIPPER

Before boarding the train, be sure to "tag on" using the card reader located at either end of the SMART station platform. You must "tag off" when you exit the train station to ensure you are charged the correct fare.
